

## Mosaic Jig Blocks

Please read through the directions before you begin. You should have knowledge of sewing as well as how to use templates to complete this project.

- Use high quality patchwork/quilting fabrics and thread for longer endurance.
- All dimensions are given in inches.
- Use a **scant** 1/4" seam allowance for all seams unless otherwise given.
- Finger press as you go. Use a warm iron to set your seams. Do not use steam to press your seams; the bias edges will become distorted. Starch if desired.
- Use a 2.0 to 2.5 stitch length for sewing.
- Snip off corners as you sew.

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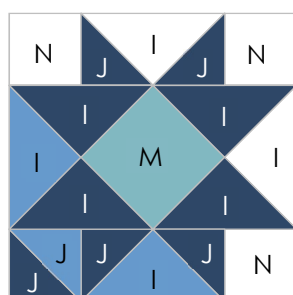

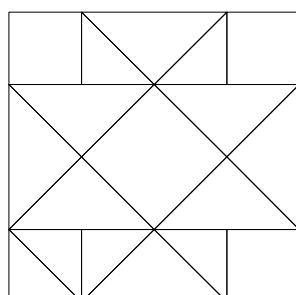

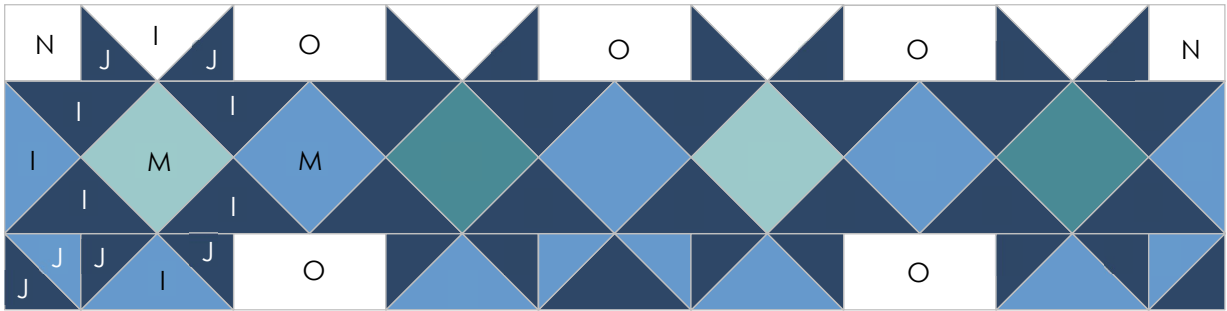

## Block Overview and Color Scheme

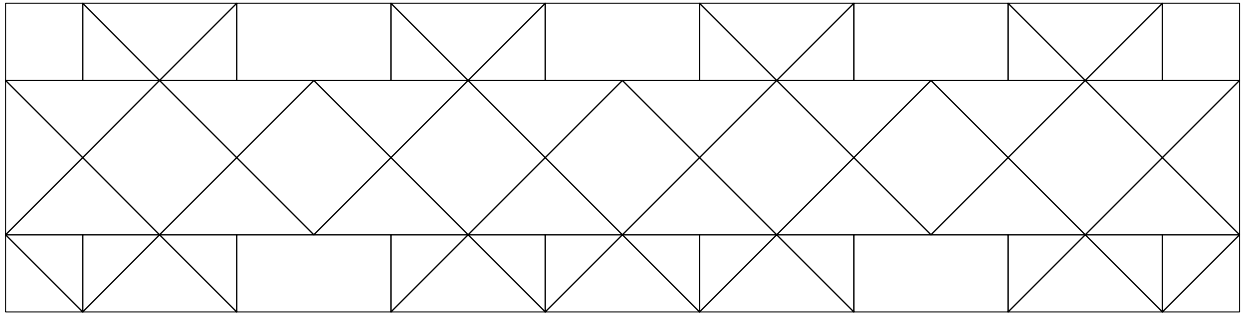


6" Mosaic Jig Block





6" x 24" Mosaic Jig Quad

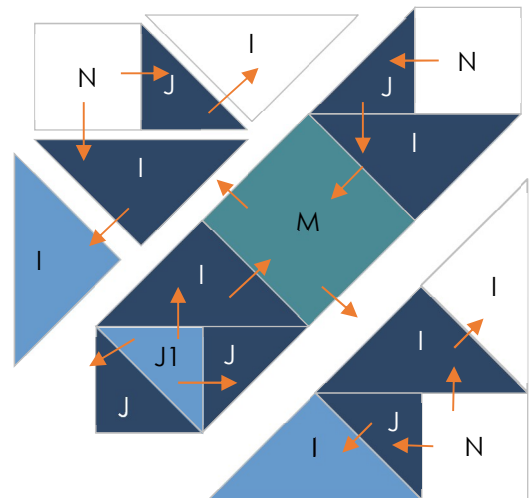


### Making the Corner Mosaic Block 6" x 6" Finished

Lay out the patches as shown. Sew together in diagonal strips according to the diagram. Press as directed. Make one test block.

#### Center Diagonal Row

1. Start at (J1). Attach one Accent (J) triangle to one Main (J) triangle. Press away from J1.
2. Sew one Accent (I) triangle to the J1/J segment. Your square patch should measure  $2\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{5}{8}$ ".
3. Attach one Accent (J) triangle to the outer corner using a slightly smaller than a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press away from center (J1).
4. On the other side, sew one Background (N) square to one Accent (J) triangle. Press towards (J).
5. Sew unit to one Accent (I) triangle.
6. Sew both segments onto the Medium 1 center (M) square. Press towards the center.



#### Corners

1. Sew one Background (N) square to one Accent (J) triangle. Press towards (J).
2. Attach one Accent (I) triangle to this segment. Press towards (I).
3. Sew one corresponding (I) triangle to each side. Press outwards towards (I).
4. Repeat for the other side. Make adjustments if needed. Press.

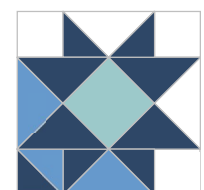
#### Finish

Sew each triangle segment to the center diagonal row. Press outwards away from the center. Your block should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make adjustments as needed.

Make (2)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks of each coloring for a total of (4) blocks.

## Making the Mosaic Jig Quad (4) Blocks 6" x 24" Finished

This block will be assembled in horizontal and diagonal rows just like the center mosaic medallion block. Make your HST's and your Flying Geese Units first. Press in the directions shown below.



Make (8) Accent/Main HST



Make (16) Main/Accent Flying Geese



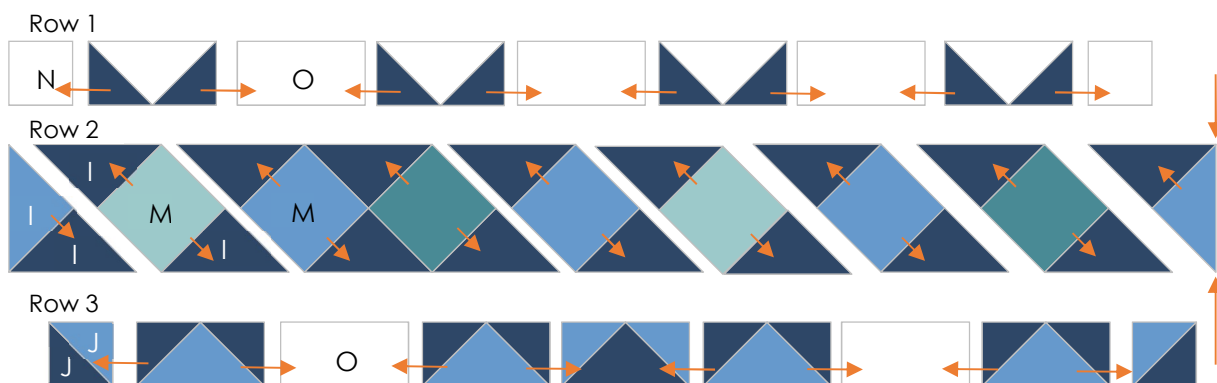
Make (4) Accent/Main HST



Make (16) Background/Accent Flying Geese

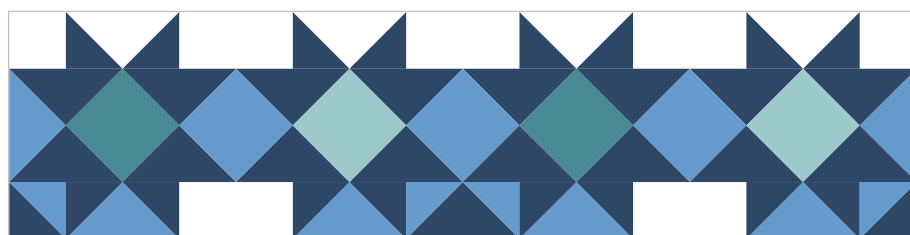
Layout remaining squares, triangles, rectangles, Flying Geese and HST's. Assemble the horizontal Row 1 first. Nest seams whenever possible. Press in the direction shown by the arrows. Measure! It should measure 24 1/2". Make adjustment to seam allowances if needed.

Make the other two rows nesting and pressing your seams in the direction shown.



Assemble all three rows. Press Row 1 and Row 3 inwards towards Row 2.

Please remember to alternate the center squares. Make (2) blocks of **each** coloring to get a total of (4) 6 1/2" x 24 1/2" blocks.



## *Mosaic Jig Quilt Along – Mosaic Jig Blocks*

Set the blocks aside for now. It is time to enjoy your accomplishment. This was very a difficult assignment, and you did a fantastic job!

The Mosaic Jig blocks will be assembled into the border starting May 14, 2019.
