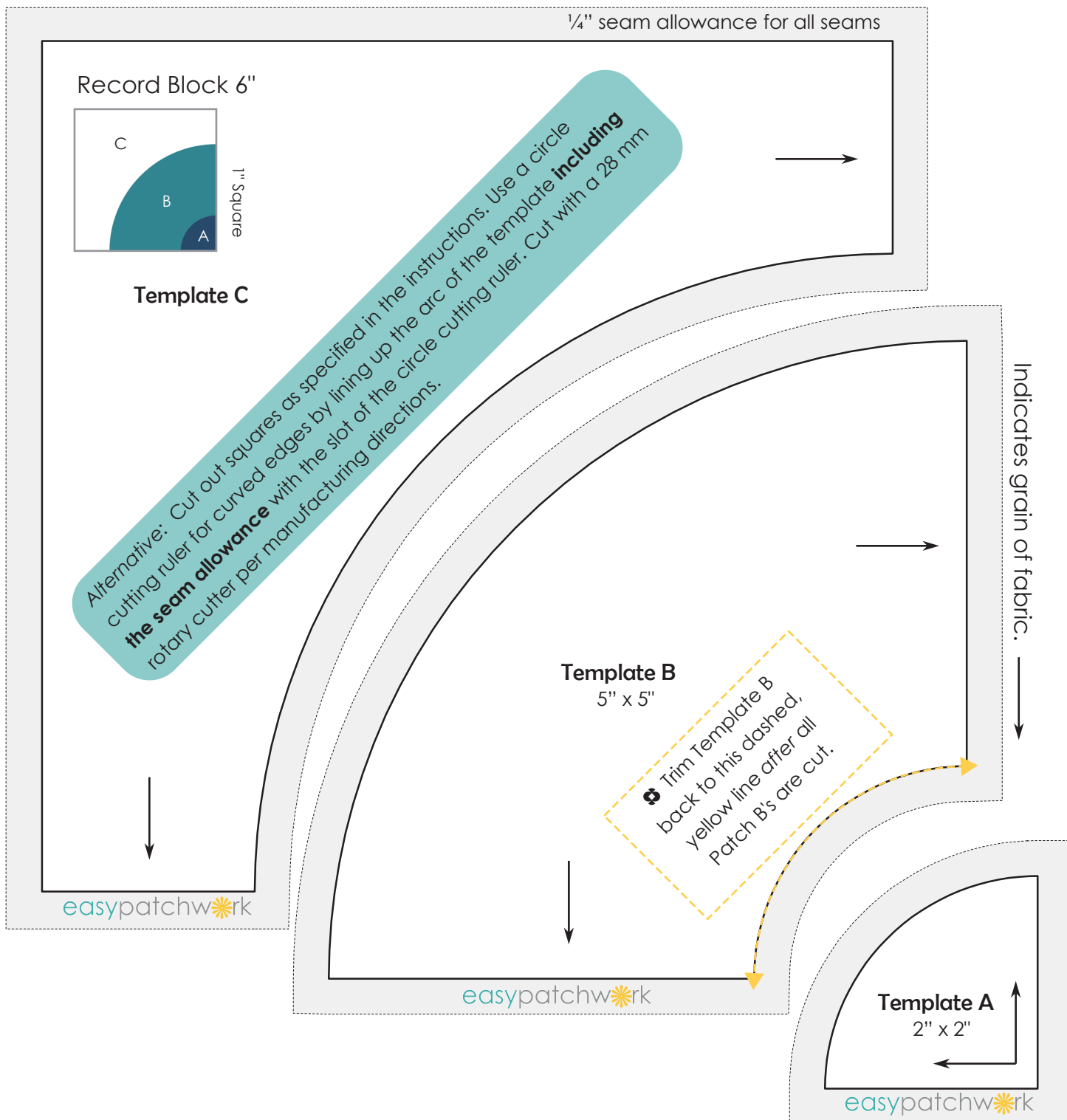


Mosaic Jig Medallion Quilt Along

Templates

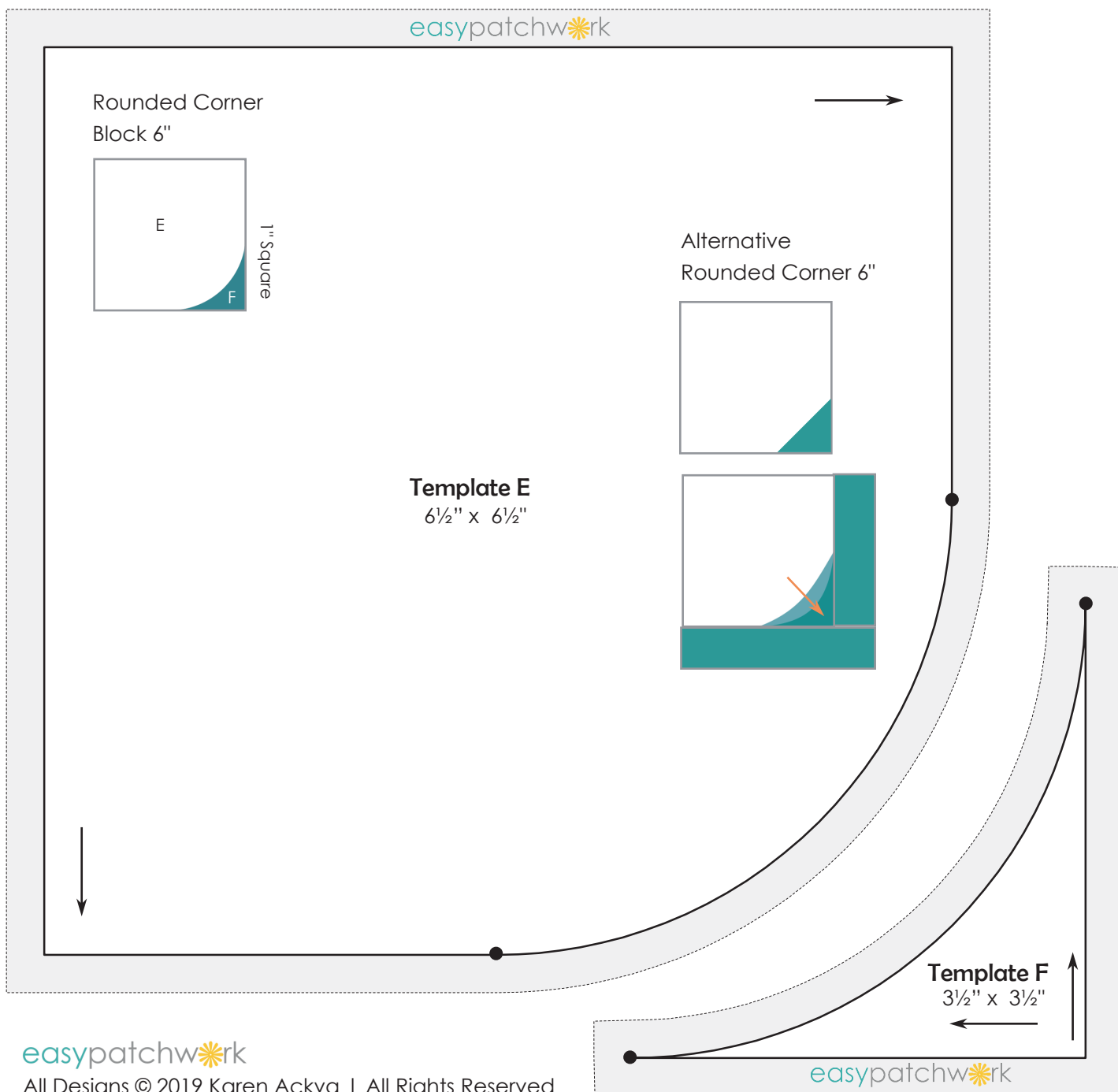
Make templates by gluing to poster board and cutting out exactly on the seam allowance lines. Pre-cut squares per instructions if desired. Trace onto the wrong side of your fabric with a pencil or removable pen/marker. Cut out with fabric scissors.



Mosaic Jig Medallion Quilt Along Templates

For the Rounded Corner Block, cut one 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" in background fabric and one 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" in main for the corner square per instructions. Finish the curves with the provided templates or a circle ruler. Transfer the dots onto the patches. You will pin at both dots before sewing together.

Alternative Block: Cut one square 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" in background fabric. Cut one square 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" for the main fabric, corner square. Fold the smaller square in half diagonally and lay it on top of the larger square in the corner. Pin in place. Sew on border. After the border is attached, pull the bias edge of the diagonally folded square towards the border of the quilt to create a curved edge. Pin in place and topstitch or quilt to secure the curve.

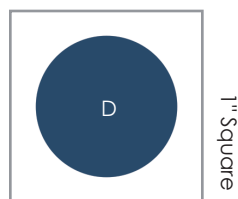


Mosaic Jig Medallion Quilt Along Templates

For the Dot Block, cut out one accent patch 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" for the dot. Trace Template D onto the wrong side of the fabric including the seam allowance. Cut out along the seam allowance. Make an appliqué dot using your favorite appliqué method such as needle turn, starch or raw edge (without the seam allowance). Center the dot in the middle of a 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" light square. (Fold both the dot and the square in half horizontally and vertically. Crease all four edges and layer atop of the intersections.) Hand or machine appliqué in place.

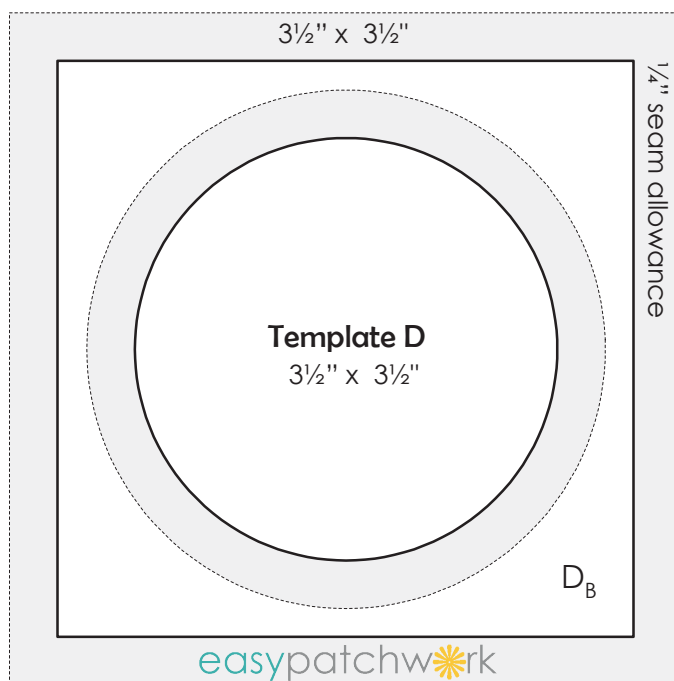
Alternative Block: Omit the Dot Block and use a 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" main fabric patch instead.

Definitions and Abbreviations

- BG – Background Fabric
- HST – Half Square Triangles
- QST – Quarter Square Triangles
- Med – Medium Fabric or Print
- RST – Right Sides Together
- WOF – Width of Fabric (Crossgrain to Selvage)
- LOF – Length of Fabric (Parallel to Selvage)
