

Center Mosaic Block

Please read through the directions before you begin. You should have knowledge of sewing as well as how to use templates to complete this project.

- Use high quality patchwork/quilting fabrics and thread for longer endurance.
- All dimensions are given in inches.
- Use a **scant** 1/4" seam allowance for all seams unless otherwise given.
- Finger press as you go. Use a warm iron to set your seams. Do not use steam to press your seams; the bias edges will become distorted. Starch if desired.
- Use a 2.0 to 2.5 stitch length for sewing.
- Snip off corners as you sew.

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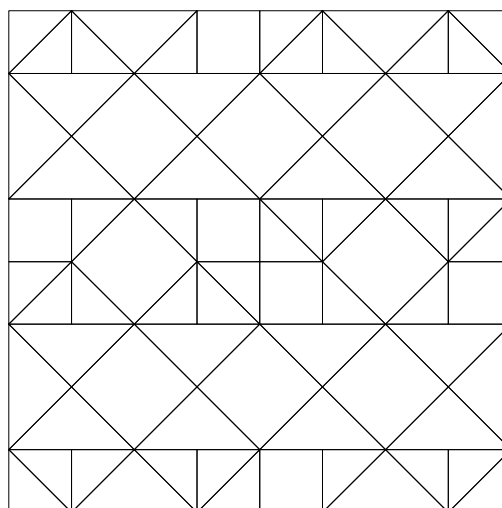
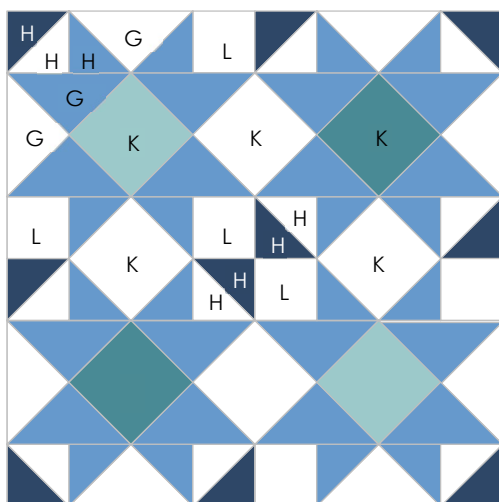

Block Overview and Color Scheme

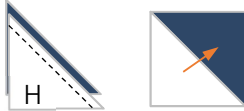


Making the Center Mosaic Block 30" x 30" Finished

Lay out all of the patches for the Mosaic Medallion block on a large area such as a wall, table or the floor. It will be assembled in horizontal and diagonal rows similar to the test block. First, subsets will be assembled and trimmed to size.

Half Square Triangles Unit

Sew one H-light to one H-dark patch along the longer side. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4 1/4" x 4 1/4". Make (10) HST units.

**Unit 1**

Sew one HST to one L square. Press towards L. Make (2) Unit 1's.

**Unit 2**

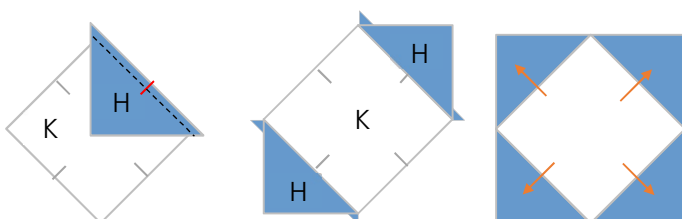
Sew one HST to one L square. Press towards L. Make (4) Unit 2's.

**Flying Geese Unit**

Place one H-triangle onto one G-triangle, RST lining up the edges of both triangles in the bottom right corner (shown with red arrow) and overlap by 1/4" on the other corner. Sew with 1/4". Press as indicated. Add the other H-triangle to the other side. Press and trim to 4 1/4" x 8". Make (4) Flying Geese Units.

**Diamond in a Square Block**

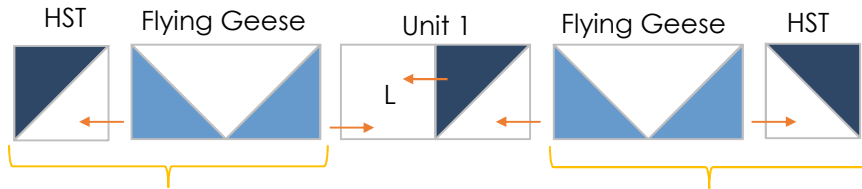
Fold all H-triangles in half on the long side and gently crease with your fingers. Fold both K-squares in half horizontally and vertically and crease at the edges with your fingers. Sew one H-triangle to one K-square right sides together, lining up the creases in the fabric. Repeat for the opposite side. Press outwards. Repeat for the other two remaining, adjacent sides. Press outwards. Trim to 8" x 8". Make (2) Diamond in a Square blocks.



Assembling the Rows

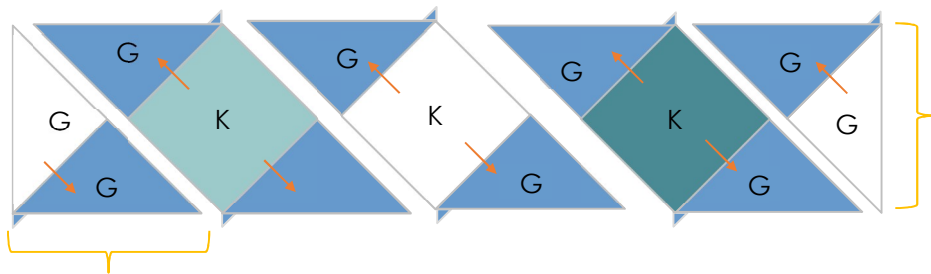
Row 1 & Row 5

1. Sew one HST unit to each corresponding Flying Geese unit nesting seams. Press outwards towards the corner.
2. Sew HST/Flying Geese unit to each side of Unit 1. Finger press in the direction shown. Make (2) rows. Set aside.



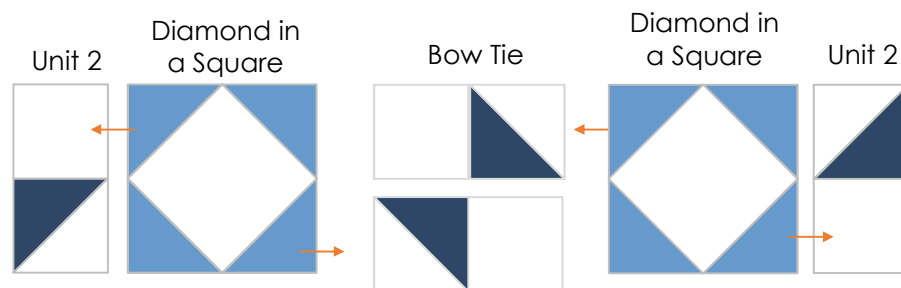
Row 2 & Row 4

1. Sew two G-triangles together. Press as shown. Repeat for the other side.
2. Sew one G-triangle to each side of corresponding K-square as shown. Press outwards. Repeat for the remaining two diagonal rows.
3. Finish the entire row by nesting seams and sewing the rows together. Finger press in the direction shown. Make (2) rows. Set aside.



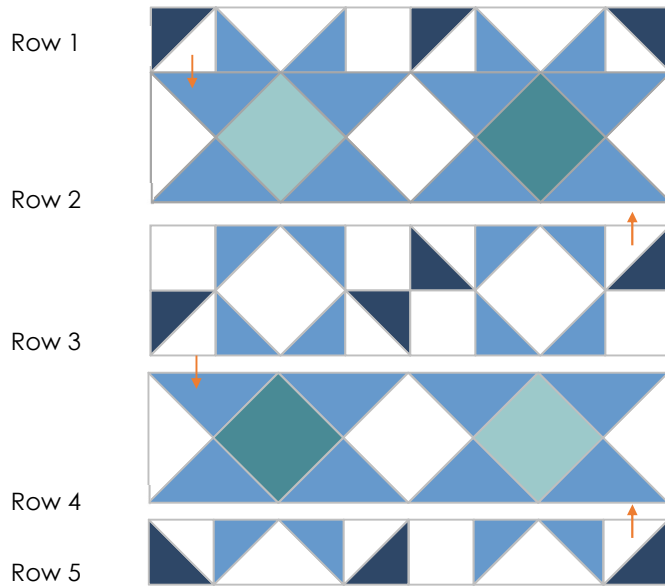
Row 3

1. Sew one Unit 2 to the correct side of each the Diamond in a Square blocks. Press towards Unit 2.
2. Make the Bow Tie block by nesting the seams of two Unit 2's together. Sew. Pop center to create a spinning. Press.
3. Finish sewing the row by connecting all units. Press in the direction shown.



Mosaie Jig Quilt Along – Center Mosaie

Lay out all of the rows and sew together. Press according to the diagram. Make one block. Trim block to 30 ½" x 30 ½".
