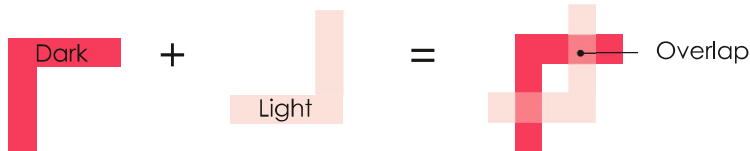
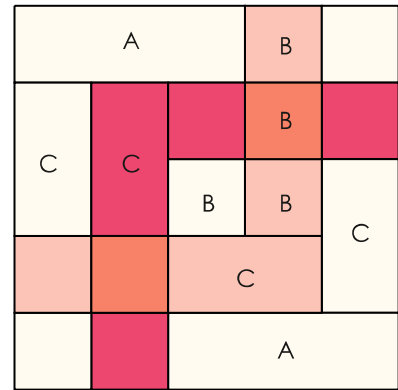


FREE 10" TRANSPARENCY QUILT BLOCK

BOOMERANG

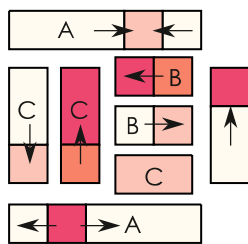
Our block is simple, easy and modern, indicating what happens when a light filter is overlaid atop a similar opaque shape. The overlap creates another color. Create this effect using light, medium and dark fabrics.

This is a beginner transparency block using basic piecing.

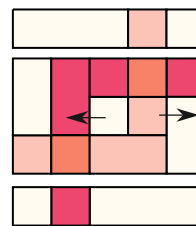


CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS			
Fabric	Patch	Dimensions	Total
Dark	B	2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	3
	C	2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	1
Light	B	2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	3
	C	2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	1
Medium or Gradient	B	2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	2
Background	A	2 1/2" x 6 1/2"	2
	B	2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	3
	C	2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	2

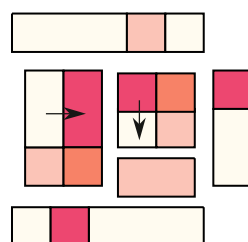
- 1 Lay out all patches as shown above. Working from the center four patch outwards, sew patches together pressing as shown to get pairs.



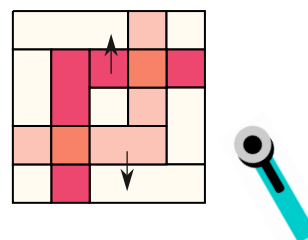
- 3 Sew segments together to get rows.



- 2 Continue to sew patches together in pairs to get segments.

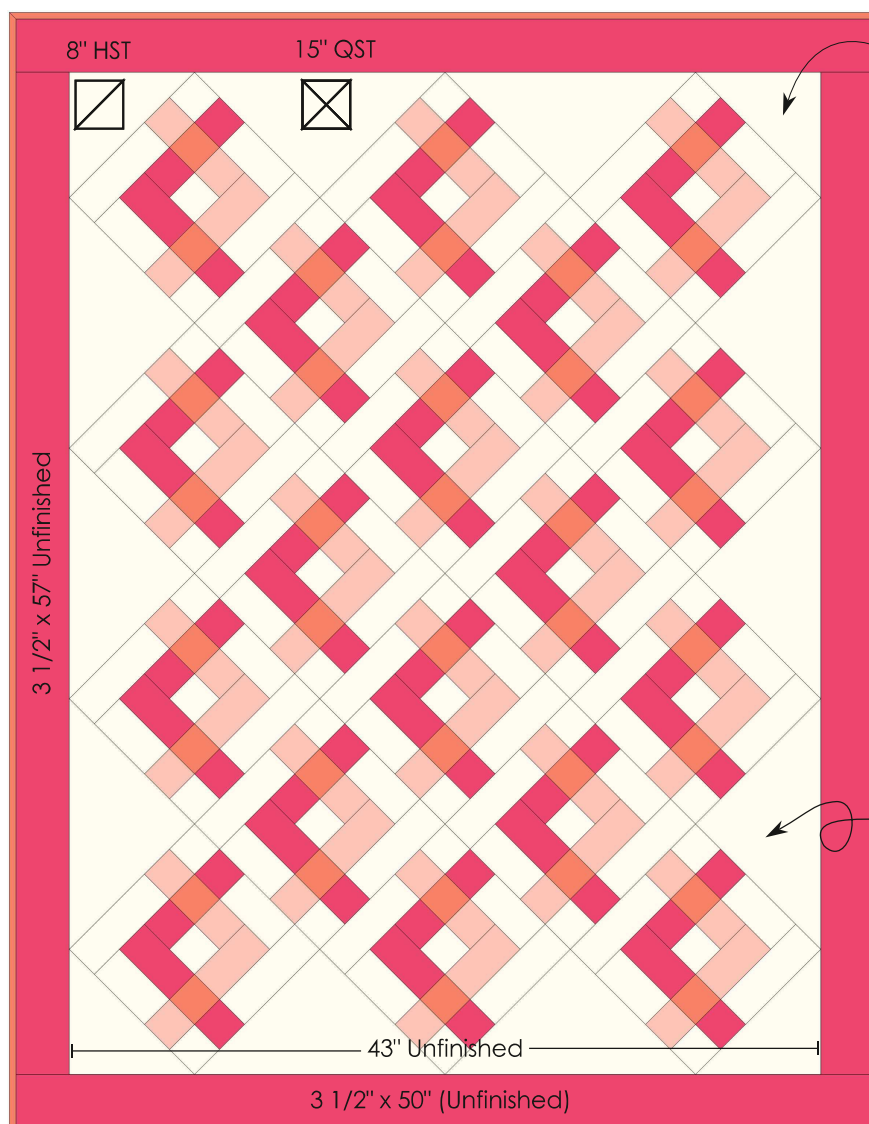


- 4 Sew rows together. Block should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2". Square if needed.



BOOMERANG QUILT IDEA FROM EASYPATCHWORK

Quilt Size ca. 50" X 64"
Block Size: 10" Finished



Cut half square triangles from 8" squares for corners.

Cut quarter square triangles from 15" squares for edge triangle patches.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Dark	1 3/4 yards
Light	1/2 yard
Medium	1/2 yard
Background	2 1/4 yards
Binding	1/2 yard
Backing/Batting	60" x 74"
